

# Associate of General Studies Degree Requirements (AGS)

Requirements	Credits	Courses which satisfy requirements
Complete a minimum of 90 credits. These must include the following:		
<b>General Education Requirements</b>		
<b>Writing</b> (A minimum of six credits with a grade of C- or better.)	6	<b>WR121</b> and one additional course from <b>WR122, 227, 240, 241, 242, 243, 244, 245, 262</b> ; or <b>BA214</b> .
<b>Math</b> (A minimum of four credits with a grade of C- or better.)	4	<b>MTH053</b> or above.
<b>Oral Communication</b> (A minimum of three credits.)	3/4	<b>COMM100</b> or above.
<b>Digital Literacy</b>	3/4	Any <b>CS</b> or <b>CIS</b> course or any of the following program-approved courses listed below. Check with your program advisor if you have any questions related to this requirement. <b>BA131</b> <b>CA100</b> <b>CIS101*</b> (or higher) <b>CIS120*</b> <b>CAM160*</b> <b>DRF165*</b> <b>HTM143*</b> <b>NUR209*</b>
<b>Physical Education or Health</b> (A maximum of 12 credits of physical education may be applied toward the degree.)	3	Any <b>PE185</b> course (one credit each), or any <b>HE</b> or <b>HPE</b> course (three credits each).
<b>Distribution Requirements</b> - Each course must be a minimum of three credits and numbered 100 or above		
<b>Arts and Letters</b> (Each course must be a minimum of three credits.)	9	Art, American Sign Language, Communication, English, Film Arts, French, Chinese, Humanities, Journalism, Japanese, Linguistics, Music, Philosophy, Religious Studies, Russian, Spanish, Theater, Writing.
<b>Social Sciences</b> (12 credits chosen from at least two disciplines. Each course must be a minimum of three credits.)	12	Anthropology, Chicano/Latino Studies, Economics, Education, Geography, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Social Science, Women's Studies.
<b>Science</b> (Eight credits of biological or physical science courses which include a laboratory.)	8	Biology, Chemistry, Geology, General Science, Physics.
<b>Electives</b> (Complete additional courses to bring the total number of credits to 90.)		Developmental courses numbered less than 050 do not meet the requirements of this degree. A maximum of 36 credit hours in career and technical education or developmental courses numbered 050-099 may be applied toward the 90 credit hours required for the degree. See <a href="#">page 199</a> for how courses are numbered. All collegiate-level courses must be numbered 100 or above.
